Homelessness Australia released statistics saying that


105,237

On any given night 1 in 200 people are homeless in Australia.

# The ABS statistical definition of homelessness is:

When a person does not have suitable accommodation alternatives they are considered homeless if their current living arrangement:

- is in a dwelling that is inadequate; or
- has no tenure, or if their initial tenure is short and not extendable; or
- does not allow them to have control of, and access to space for special relations.

To help with this, I have tried to design something that incorporates a simple pleasure item and make it into something practical. Whilst researching pleasure, I came across a certain type of beach bed that had started to become popular amongst beach goers. It was an inflatable beach pillow that had one end open with clip buckles either side. This was so that when you open the end up, it' would fill with air and you could roll that end up and clip it shut. This kind of technique is also used on waterproof bags. The material is airtight and sturdy so that when you lie on it, it's almost like an air mattress.

The idea behind my design is to merge this beach pillow with a single person, lightweight, pop-up tent that is collapsible so that instead of sleeping on the harsh, cold ground from night to night someone could inflate the beach pillow, pop the tent up and then connect them using clips on the sides. This would get the user off the cold ground and shelter them from wind and rain.








# Final Design:

- Fire and water resistant, 185T/68D polyester fly with 185T polyester floor
- Instant pop-up frame with pre-assembled poles for easy and quick setup
- Packs up flat for easy storage




- Strong, lightweight , nylon parachute fabric with special coating
- Weight: 1.3kg, Length: 225cm,

Width: 95cm

• Tested on sharp rocks, uneven ground, sand, shells, grass and concrete

### How To Fold Back Pop-Up Beach Tent


































Fold up and easily strap the two parts together by inserting bottom of bed into holder then cliping around upper half to secure to tent
